SiPhuthi Translation

El Shaddai ufuna kutsi uphile imphilo ngekugcwala kwayo konkhe. Uyakutsandza kakhulu, futsi uneluhlelo lolukhetsekile ngemphilo yakho. Kodvwa kunendlela yinye kuphela yekucala luhambo lwakho lwekuya ekupheleni kwakho: kwemukela insindziso ngeNdvodzana ya-El Shaddai, Jesu Khristu. Ngekufa nekuvuka kwaJesu, El Shaddai ukwentele indlela yekungena embusweni Wakhe njengendvodzana noma indvodzakati letsandzekako. Umhlatjelo waJesu eSiphambanweni wente imphilo yaphakadze nemphilo lenengi itfolakale kuwe mahhala. Insindziso isipho lesivela ku-El Shaddai kuwe; kute longakwenta kutsi uyitfole noma uyifanele.

Kute wemukele lesipho lesiligugu, cala uvume sono sakho sekuphila utimele ngaphandle kweMdali wakho, ngoba loku kuyimphandze yato tonkhe tono lotentile.

ENGLISH REFERENCE

English translation

El Shaddai wants you to experience life in its fullness. He loves you deeply and has a specific plan for your life. But there is only one way to start the journey to your destiny: to receive salvation through God's Son, Jesus Christ. Through the death and resurrection of Jesus, El Shaddai made a way for you to enter His kingdom as a beloved son or daughter. The sacrifice of Jesus on the Cross made eternal and abundant life freely available to you. Salvation is a gift from El Shaddai to you; you can do nothing to earn or deserve it.

To receive this precious gift, first acknowledge your sin of living independently of your Creator, for this is the root of all the sins you have committed.

Kuphendvuka kuyingcenyebalulekile yekwemukela insindziso. Petro wakucacisa loko ngelilanga lapho bantfu labatinkhulungwane letintsatfu basindziswa eNcwadzi yeMisebenti: “Ngako phendvukani, niguquke, kuze tonotenu tesulwe” (Imisebenti 2:38–41 ESV). Imibhalo imemetela kutsi ngamunye wetfu utalwa ayisigcili sesono. Lobu bugcili bumile esonweni sa-Adamu, lowacala indlela yekungalaleli ngemabomu. Kuphendvuka kukukhetsa kufulathela kulalela wena ngekwakho naSathane, uyise wemanga, bese uphendvukela ekulaleleni iNkhosi yakho lensha, Jesu Khristu — Loyo lowanikela imphilo Yakhe ngawe. Kufanele unike Jesu bukhosi bemphilo yakho. Kwenta Jesu abe “yiNkhosi” kusho kumnika bunini bemphilo yakho: umoya, umphefumulo, nemtimba — konkhe lokunguwo nakho konkhe lonako. Ligunya Lakhe etulu kwemphilo yakho liba liphelele. Ngesikhatsi wenta loku, El Shaddai uyakukhulula ebumnyameni akudlulisele ekukhanyeni nasenkazimulweni yembuso Wakhe. Usuka nje ekufeni uye ekuphileni — uba ngumntfwana Wakhe!

Uma ufuna kwemukela insindziso ngajesu, thandaza lamavi:

Repentance is a vital part of receiving salvation. Peter made this clear on the day that three thousand were saved in the Book of Acts: “Repent therefore and be converted, that your sins may be blotted out” (Acts 2:38–41 ESV). Scripture declares that each of us is born a slave to sin. This slavery is rooted in the sin of Adam, who began the pattern of willful disobedience. Repentance is a choice to turn away from obedience to yourself and to Satan, the father of lies, and to turn in obedience to your new Master, Jesus Christ — the One who gave His life for you. You must give Jesus the lordship of your life. Making Jesus “Lord” means giving Him ownership of your life (spirit, soul, and body)—everything you are and have. His authority over your life becomes absolute. At the moment you do this, El Shaddai delivers you from darkness and transfers you to the light and glory of His kingdom. You simply go from death to life — you become His child!

If you want to receive salvation through Jesus, pray these words:

El Shaddai loseZulwini, ngiyavuma kutsi ngiyisoni futsi ngehlulekile kufinyelela ezingeni Lakho lekuhlunga. Ngifanele kugwetjwa phakadze ngesono sami. Ngiyabonga ngoba Awungishiyanga kulesimo, ngoba ngiyakholwa kutsi Watfumela Jesu Khristu, iNdvodzana Yakho leyodvwa, lowatalwa yiNtombi Mariya, kutsi afe ngawe futsi atfwale sigwebo sami eSiphambanweni. Ngiyakholwa kutsi wavuswa ngelilanga lesitsatfu futsi manje uhlezi ngesekudla Sakho njengeNkhosi noMsindzisi wami. Ngako-ke, ngalelilanga, ngiyaphendvuka ekutimeleleni kwami ngaphandle Kwakho, futsi nginikela imphilo yami yonkhe ebukhosini baJesu. Jesu, ngiyakuvuma njengeNkhosi noMsindzisi wami. Ngena emphilweni yami ngoMoya Wakho, ungiguqule ngibe ngumntfwana wa-El Shaddai. Ngiyalahla tintfo tebumnyama lengake ngabambelela kuto, futsi kusukela namuhla kuye phambili, angeke ngisaphilela mine. Kodvwa ngemusa Wakho, ngitawuphilela Wena, Wena lowatinikela ngawe kutsi ngiphile phakadze. Ngiyabonga, Nkhosi; imphilo yami manje isezandleni Takho ngokuphelele, futsi ngekuya ngeLizwi Lakho, angeke ngihlazeke naphakadze. Egameni laJesu, Amen.
